YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Applicant, Delaware County, Iowa desires to take, acquire and condemn an easement in non-agricultural land for a public utility and temporary construction easement in connection with the Petersburg Wastewater Treatment Facility Project, located in the Unincorporated Area of Petersburg, along 299th Avenue, Delaware County, Iowa, approved by the Board of Supervisors of Delaware County, Iowa. The County has not been able to secure rights in lands by purchase and conveyance. Minimum Land Needs: The minimum amount of land necessary to achieve the public purpose is as described in and shown on the Notice of Condemnation and attached plat(s).

Names and Addresses: The names and addresses of the record owners, lienholders, encumbrancers, and other persons affected by this proceeding are listed on the attached Notice of Condemnation.

Purpose: The County desires the rights specified in the land sought to be condemned for the construction, operation, maintenance, repair, use, and reconstruction of a permanent sanitary sewer main.

Good Faith Negotiations: The Applicant has been unable to negotiate in good faith with the owner(s) to acquire the property sought to be condemned, as the titleholders are deceased.

Request: NOW, THEREFORE, Delaware County hereby requests the appointment of a compensation commission of six qualified persons to view the premises and appraise the damages which the owners, lienholders, encumbrancers, and other persons affected will sustain by reason of this Condemnation.

- 3. This easement includes the right to make excavations and to grade as it may reasonable be necessary for the construction, installation, operation, repair, maintenance, and reconstruction of the sanitary sewer main in the permanent easement area.
- 4. The Applicant shall have the right to trim and remove all trees and bushes which may interfere with Applicant's use of the easement.
- 5. Condemner hereby gives notice of condemnees' five-year right to negotiate construction or maintenance damages not apparent at the time of the condemnation as required by Iowa Code Section 6B.52.


