NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT

On Thursday Nov. 11, 2021 I completed a Time of Transfer Inspection for a septic system with a total of two bedrooms in Delaware county. Delaware County Health Department did have a septic installation permit number. There is a shared well for the property to the west of the property. The cabin at Lake Delhi has no basement. The waste water exits by gravity to the west side of the house draining to a old round single compartment concrete septic tank. This is the primary treatment according to Iowa Code 567(69)- it was at the proper liquid level on the day of inspection. There is no effluent filter on the outlet of the septic tank. The outlet of the septic tank is by gravity to another plastic tank that was added in 2003. There is 55 linear feet of rock and pipe system, which completes the secondary treatment.

CONDITION:

The septic tank was pumped on Nov. 11, 2021 by Groth Services and satisfies the three year requirement for this inspection. Normal septic tank cleanings are recommended in order to keep these solids from flowing out into the absorption system every 1.5 years. The septic tank access risers were not sealed and were replaced while onsite. The inlet baffle is concrete and the outlet was a plastic tee are functioning as designed. There is no distribution box on this site, but the header was found 50" deep with a sonde locator. A hydraulic load test was not completed, due to the cabin being vacant for more than 60 days. There were no wet spots found in the yard. This septic system is not in a desirable location, as it is being driven across by vehicles. There is only one cabin now connected to this system, 21671 has been removed. The system is grossly undersized to today's standards.


This septic inspection was completed at 21681 258th st. Delhi, IA on 11-11-2021 and is valid for two years from this date for the transfer of real estate.

There are 2 additional pages of pictures included to this report of the system components. The two page DNR form 542-0191 has been completed and a required sketch has been drawn as part of this inspection and attached.
