This system is part of a multi property collection sewer main called Middle system which flows to an Orenco dual pod AX-20 treatment system There are 10 seasonal cabins connected to this "middle system". They are 23082, 23094, 23102, 23110, 23116, 23124, 23157, 23164 - all on263rd St., and 23168, 23105, on 264th St.

The Large 6,000 gal. septic tank for the middle system was pumped on 7/21/2023 for time of transfer inspection. There is a large effluent filter on the outlet which then flows to the 2,000-treatment tank, or recirc tank for the AX 20, dual pod treatment system. After this treatment the effluent flows through a small 300 sq. ft. tertiary, rock and pipe bed. There is a vent/outlet, plumbed above the distribution system in the tertiary bed to the open outlet.

### Responsibilities of Service Provider

- 1. Groth Services LLC shall conduct an annual inspection of the AdvanTex Textile Filter wastewater treatment system. Inspections shall include the following items:
  - Visual inspection of all septic tanks.
  - Sludge/scum measurement of all septic tanks. Does not include pumping and disposal of any tanks.
     Inspection and cleaning, if necessary, of the BioTube, Pump Vault and (3) sensor floats.
     Inspection and cleaning, if necessary, of the ORENCO recirculation pump.
