Found top of Septic Tank and outlet end of tank is structurally cracked. Also, tank is cracked vertically on end of tank. Did water hydraulic load test from D-Box for a 4 Bedroom Home at 300 gals. Soil Absorption system accepted the water load test without any slowness or backups.
