

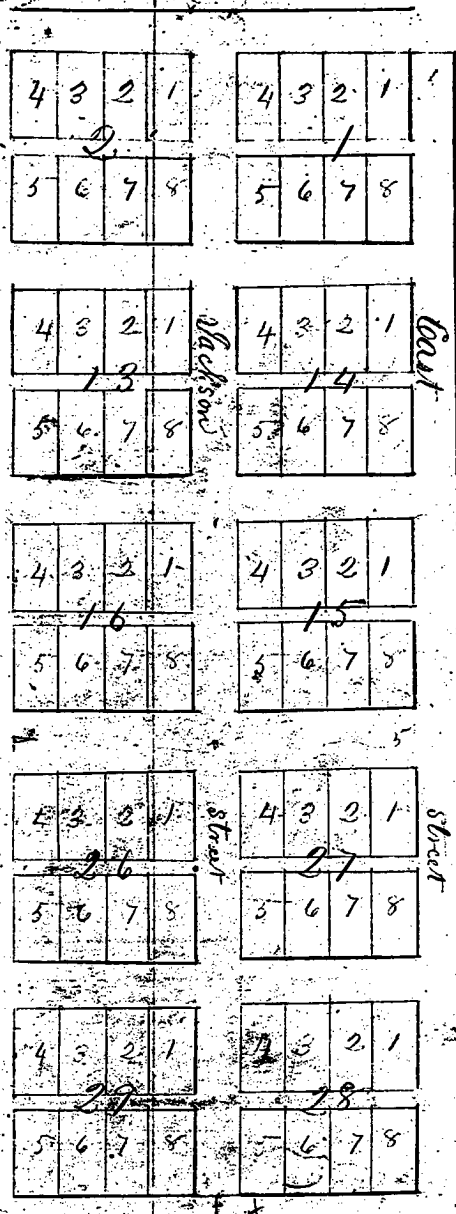

 Madison County. said County do hereby certify that by order of
 the County Commissioners of said County
 surveyed, laid out and platted the Town of Winterset, in
 the State of Iowa, which Town is situated in the West
 half of the South West quarter of Section Thirty One, Township
 Six North of Range Twenty Seven West of the Fifth Principal
 Meridian in the State aforesaid and in the East half of the South
 East quarter of Section Thirty Six in Township Six North
 Range Twenty Eight West of said Meridian.
 The lots in said Town are sixty six feet in width, except
 lot four which is eighty two and a half feet in width.



The Courses of East, Jackson, Madison, West
 Polk, Taylor, Locust and West Street is north
 and South, and the Course of North Green,
 Jefferson, Court Avenue, Washington and
 South Street and also the lines 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8
 East and West as represented on said plat of
 the town. The number of lots in said town
 is two hundred and twenty-two and one half
 -the square marker R. The lots as repre-
 sented on said plat are one hundred and thirty-
 two feet in length North and South and sixty
 six feet in width East and West except lots
 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 in Block No 18 and 34, 5, 6 in Block 17
 which are one hundred and thirty-two feet
 in length East and West and sixty feet
 in width North and South all of which lots
 contain one fifth of an acre each.
 The Public Square is four chains in width
 East and West and four chains and a quarter
 North and South and contains one acre and
 seven tenths and is situated between blocks
 Eleven, eighteen, twenty-four and seven and
 designated on said plat. The stone planted
 by order of the Commissioners of said County
 from which to make future surveys is
 marked and designated on said plat this
 "O. Stone" and at the South West corner
 of lot number four in Block number twelve
 and at the North East corner of the Public
 square in the town of Lister.

 town of Madison in said County of Madison to be the plat
 of the seat of Justice of said County, as directed by law
 and placed by said David L. Smith, County Commissioner
 for said County, and to be the seat of Justice of said County.

And that the said ~~County~~ Certificate of the said ~~County~~ Trust ~~Trust~~ allotted
is correct and no such further in behalf of the County aforesaid
give grant, and donate all the streets and alleys in said Town
as delineated as are now represented on the above plat for the use of
the public as highways except the Public Square in said town which
is hereby reserved for the use of said County Board and for
the purposes of erecting a Court house and other public buildings there-
on as may hereafter be determined.

In testimony whereof, for and on behalf of said board we have hereunto set our hands and caused the temporary seal of said board to be hereunto affixed, under the same attested by the clerk of the board of Commissioners of said County at New York this 23rd day of July 1849.
