County of Madison in the State of Iowa for and in the consideration of one hundred and twenty seven dollars and fifty cents to us in hand paid by - do grant bargain & sell to Joseph S. Wright of the County of Madison & State aforesaid the following described land to wit the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Sec $\frac{1}{2}$ of R. 15 in Township 15 N. of Range 28 West. Contain in or about four acres more or less - And further we do covenant that we shall forever quietly enjoy the same and that free from all incumbrance and that we do warrant that we will forever defend the same from any person or persons whomsoever and the said Mary J. Wright wife of the said Joseph S. Wright does forever relinquish her dower to said land In testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals this the ninth day of February AD 1832
