This indenture made the twenty-seventh day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty two between Solomon Grimes and James Grimes his wife of the County of Putnam and State of Indiana of the one part and William Williams of the County and State aforesaid of the other party witnesseth that the said Solomon Grimes for and in consideration of seven hundred and sixty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said William Williams the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold convey'd & confirmed and doth by these presents grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said William Williams his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land in the County of Madison and State of Iowa it being the one undivided half of the Northwest quarter of section sixteen and the Northwest quarter of section eight & the Northeast quarter of section eight and the North half of the Southeast quarter & the North half of the Southwest quarter of section eight all in Township Seventy five North of

lands twenty six acres containing in all six hundred and forty acres be the same more or less. Together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging and the reversion - remainder and profits thereof and all the estate title and interest of the said Solomon Grimes in and to the same. To have & to hold the premises aforesaid with all their appurtenances to the only proper use - benefit & behoof of the said William Williams his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Solomon Grimes for himself his heirs executors & administrators doth covenant and agree to and with the said William Williams his heirs and assigns that he the said Solomon Grimes lawfully seized in fee of the premises aforesaid that they are free from all incumbrances and that he has good right to sell and convey the same in manner and form aforesaid and further that he and his heirs executors & administrators shall and will warrant and defend the said premises to the said William Williams his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of himself and his heirs and also against the lawful claim or claims of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Solomon Grimes and Anna Grimes his wife who hereby relinquishes all her rights to down in and to the foregoing described premises have hereunto set their hands and seals the 29<sup>th</sup> of March first above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of

Be it remembered that the witness named Solomon Grimes his wife and Anna Grimes his wife known to me to be the persons who executed the foregoing deed came this day personally before me the undersigned a Justice of the peace in and for the County of Putnam aforesaid and each severally acknowledged that they or each of them did sign seal & deliver the within and foregoing indenture as and for their & each of their own act and deed that the said Anna Grimes wife of the said Solomon being of full age & the full contents & purport of the said indenture having been by the first made known to her & being by one repeated & apart from her & without the hearing of her said husband privately examined upon such separate examination she did declare & acknowledge that she voluntarily & of her free will and accord and without any coercion or compulsion from her said husband signed sealed and delivered the said indenture for the purpose therein mentioned and relinquished all her right to down to the within described premises.
