I know all men by these presents that we Henry McKenzie April S. Allcock  
and Edward Commissioners of Madison  
County Iowa now in session as a board  
of the business in behalf of said County for and in consideration  
of the sum of fifty dollars paid into the treasury of said County  
by Abraham Shoemaker have granted bargained and sold and  
by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the  
said Abraham Shoemaker his heirs and assigns the follow-  
ing real estate to wit: lot No three (3) in Block no twenty-  
four (24) also lot No seven (7) in Block no nineteen (19).  
in the town of Winterport the seat of Justice for Madison  
County Iowa to have and to hold a said premises with  
the appurtenances unto the said Abraham Shoemaker his  
heirs and assigns forever and the said Board of Commissioners  
for themselves and their successors in office hereby con-  
tract to agree with the said Abraham Shoemaker his heirs  
and assigns that they are lawfully seised of the pre-  
mises aforesaid that the premises are free and clear from  
all incumbrances whatsoever and that they will for  
ever warrant and defend the same against the  
lawful claims of all persons whosoever the testi-  
mony whereof are the said Commissioners hereunto  
set our hands and affix our corporal affector seal  
this the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April AD 1851.
