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This indenture made this 27th day
of October 1832 between Jesse
C. Young and Mary Jane Young
his wife of the County of Madison
and State of Iowa of the first

part and John C. Hollingsworth of the County of Warren and State of Iowa of the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part and for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars in hand paid by said party of the second the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath Jesse C. Young bargained and sold remised, released, aliened and confirmed & by these presents do his grant bargain sell remise release alien & confirm unto the party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of land & premises situated and being in the County of Madison & State of Iowa & bounded and described as follows to wit: The South East quarter of the NE 1/4 of section 16 Township twenty first (21) North of Range Twenty six (26) West of the fifth P.M. containing forty acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to have and to hold the above granted premises to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns to the lawful use & behoof forever and the said party of the first part for their heirs executors and administrators Covenant with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns that they are lawfully seized of the aforesaid premises that they are free from all encumbrances that they have good right to sell and convey the same to the said party of the second part as aforesaid & that they will forever warrant and defend the same to the said party of the second part as aforesaid & that they will forever warrant and defend the same to the said party of the second part his heirs & assigns against the lawful demands of all persons. And the said Mary Jane Young in an examination separate and apart from her husband acknowledged that she executed the same & that she relinquished her right of dower to the real Estate therein named and that she does freely and without compulsion or undue influence from her said husband
