To all to whom these presents 143
shall come greeting Know ye
that in pursuance of an act of
Congress entitled "an act to raise for

a limited time an additional Military force and for other
purposes Approved Feb 11th 1847 Lydia A Rogers Adm
and her ex-husband Horatio Rogers created private in Compa
ny 2d South Regiment United States Infantry bearing
oppositid in the General Land office a Warrant in
her favor numbered 72.9.13- There is therefore granted by
the United States unto Christian Fosher; assignee of
said Lydia A Rogers and to his heirs the South West Qu
arter of section thirty four. In Township twenty six north
of Range Twenty Eight (28) in the East of Lands subject
to sale at the Land office at Lead City Iowa containing
one hundred and sixty acres. According to the official plat of
the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the
Surveyor General wherein said tract has been located in satis
faction of the above mentioned Warrant. In pursuance of the act of
Congress above mentioned Approved Feb 11th 1847 I have
to hold the said Quarter section of land with the appurte
nances thereof unto the said Christian Fosher and to his
heirs and assigns forever In testimony whereof I Millard Fillmore
President of the United States of America have caused these
Letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to
be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City of Wash
ington the first day of October in the Year of our Lord
One thousand Eight hundred and fifty one and of the
Independence of the United States the 16th the President
Millard Fillmore By Alex W. Cornwell Act Secy
