This indenture made this fifth day of

between hundred and fifty-one between
Christian Jacobs and Nancy Jacobs

of the County of Boone and State of Indiana of the first part and Peter C. Freeman
Esquire of the same place of the second part Witnesseth that the said party
of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars hereinafter
in hand by the party of the second part the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged
have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns
forever the following described piece and parcel of land situate in the State of Indiana
to-wit the North West q^r of the North East q^r of Section thirty
two (32) in Township twenty six (26) North of Range twenty eight (28) West
of the same subject to sale at Paris city together with all the improvements and
appurtenances to the same belonging to have and to hold the same to the
only purpose benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part
his heirs and assigns forever and the said parties of the first part
for themselves their heirs Executors administrators and assigns do hereby
covenant to and with the said party of the second part that they are
lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid and that they are free and
clear from all incumbrances whatsoever and they will forever warrant
defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever

his wife as aforesaid who hereby relinquish her right of dower
in said premises have hereunto set their hands and seals this 10th day
of November A.D. 1837 signed sealed and

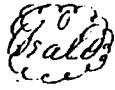
