 Patent to all whom these presents shall
 come greeting know ye that in pursu-
 -ance of an act of Congress entitled an act to raise for
 a limited time an additional military force and
 for other purposes approved February 11th 1847 Milton
 L Wythe late a private in Captain Cochran's Company
 of the 10th Regiment Indiana Volunteers having
 deposited in the General Land office a warrant
 in his favor numbered 16579 there is therefore
 granted by the United States unto William
 Foster assignee of Sarge Milton L Wythe and
 to his heirs the North East fractional quarter
 of Section Two in Township Seventy Six North
 of Range twenty Eight West in the District of
 Land Subject to Sale at Iowa City Iowa containing
 one hundred fifty six acres and thirty five
 hundredths of an acre according to the official plat
 of the Survey of the said land returned to the general
 land office by the Surveyor General which said tract
 had been locked in satisfaction of the above
 mentioned warrant in pursuance of the act of con-
 -gress above mentioned approved February 11th 1847
 to have and to hold the said part of said section of
 land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said
 William Foster and to his heirs and assigns forever in
 testimony whereof I Millard Fillmore president of the
 United States of America have caused these letters to be made
 patent and the seal of the general Land office to be hereunto
 affixed Given under my hand at Washington City the second
 day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and fifty two and of the Independence of the Uni-
 -ted States the 76 by the president Millard Fillmore
