Twenty Seven (27) West of the 6th P.M. Town Expressing
Ten acres off of the East Side of the same making the
amount conveyed thirty acres & the East half of the West
half of the North East quarter of Section Thirty 30
Township No Seventy Six, Range 10 Twenty Seven
(27) West Madison County Iowa containing forty
acres more or less and we do hereby covenant with the
said Nathan Garrison that we are lawfully seized of said
premises that they are free from encumbrances that we
have good right and lawful authority to sell the same
and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the
said premises against the lawful claims of all persons
