of the County of Madison & state of Iowa in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars in hand paid by Oliver Crawford of Coshocton County Ohio have bargained and sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Oliver Crawford his heirs and assigns forever the following premises to wit: The North East quarter of the North East q^r of Sec. 17 & the South East q^r of the South East q^r of Sec. 17 & 8th in Township 76 of Range 26 5th P.M. Iowa. To have & to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Oliver Crawford his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises of record that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrances whatsoever & that he will forever warrant & defend the same unto the said Oliver Crawford against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
