Come Creating Know ye that

in pursuance of an act of Congress entitled an act to raise for
a limited time an additional Military force and for
other purposes approved Feb 11th 1847 Mary E Bonmarsh
widow of Edward Bonmarsh deceased Late private in the
Eleventh Regiment United States Infantry having deposited
in the General Land Office a Warrant in her favor
numbered 63699. There is therefore granted by the United
States unto Christian Fosker assignee of Mr Chas
Sally Guardian of the said Mary E Bonmarsh and to his
heirs the South East quarter of Sec 33 in T 76

North Range Twenty eight West in the District of Land subject to
 sale by the Land Office at Land City Iowa containing One
 hundred and thirty acres according to the Official plat of
 the survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office
 by the Surveyor General which said tract of Land has been located
 in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant in pursuance
 of the Act of Congress Feb 11th 1827. To have and to
 hold the said part of said Land with the appurtenances
 thereunto to said Christian Foshier and to his heirs &
 assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Millard Fillmore
 President of the United States have caused these Letters
 to be made public and the seal of the General Land Office to
 be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand and seal at
 the City of Washington the first day of June in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two of
 the independence of the United States the fourth.
