

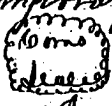

and State of Iowa now in session as a board holding to county  
business for said County for and in consideration of fifty  
one dollars and twenty five cents in hand paid by George W.  
McCallan. at & before the sealing and delivering of these presents  
have granted bargained & sold by these presents do grant bargain  
and convey unto the said George W. McCallan his heirs and  
assigns forever the following premises to wit: Lots Nos (2) in  
Block No. Twenty four (24) Also in lot No three (3) in Block  
No 191 Nineteen in the town of Whiteset in the County of Madison  
of one said to have & to hold said premises with the appurtenances  
unto the said George W. McCallan his heirs & assigns forever &  
the said Board of Commissioners for themselves and their suc-  
cessors in office do hereby covenant with said McCallan his heirs  
and assigns that the premises are free and clear from all incum-  
berances whosoever & that they will forever warrant and defend  
the same unto the said George W. McCallan his heirs and assigns  
forever against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever. In  
witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and official au-  
thority at the City of Iowa this 6th day of January A.D. 1831.
