 of the sum of two hundred dollars to them paid by the said
 of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained sold released & conveyed by these
 presents doth grant bargain sell release & convey to the
 said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever
 all their certain pieces or parcels of Land situate lying
 & being in the County of Madison in the State of Iowa
 and more designated and described as follows to wit
 the west half of the South west quarter of Section
 twenty one and the East half of the South East quarter
 of Section twenty in Township seventy six North of
 Range twenty eight west in the district of Lands
 subject to sale at Iowa City Iowa containing one
 hundred and sixty acres more or less

Together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the
 said land in anywise appertaining & belonging to have
 & to hold the above granted premises to the said party of
 the second part his heirs & assigns to his and their
 next heirs forever & the said William Wood and Polly
 his wife party of the first part for themselves their
 heirs Executors & administrators doth Covenant with the
 said party of the second part his heirs & assigns that
 they are lawfully seized in fee of the above granted
 premises that they are free from all incumbrances that
 they the said party of the first part have good right
 to sell & convey the same to the said party of the
 second part as aforesaid & that they will and their
 heirs Executors & administrators shall warrant and
 defend the same to the said party of the second part
