The United States of America do all to whom
this presents shall come Greeting Know ye that
in pursuance of an act of Congress entitled an
act to raise upon a limited time an additional
military force and for other purposes approved

February 11th 1847 David Hife late a private Captain Gregg's
Company Eleventh Regiment United States Infantry having deposited
in the General Land office a warrant in his name numbered
59241 there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said
David Hife and to his heirs the north west quarter of section twelve
in Township Seventy five north of Range Twenty six west
of the fifth principal meridian in the District of Iowa
subject to sale at Fairfield Iowa containing one hundred and
fifty acres according to the official plat of Survey of the
said land returned to the general land office by the survey-
or General which said tract has been located in satisfaction
of the above mentioned warrant in pursuance of the act of Congress
above mentioned approved February 11th 1847 to have and to hold
the said quarter section of land with the appurtenances there-
unto unto the said David Hife and to his heirs and assigns
Forever In testimony whereof I William Williamson president
of the United States of America have caused these letters to be
made patent and the Seal of the General Land office to be
hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington
the first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty one and of the Independence of the
United States the thirtieth sixth By the president
