

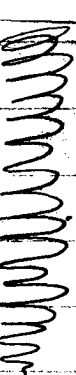

to the Said pendleton all of the following described
personal property to wit one Team horse three
old one barrel mow and one old one

Springe Colt and two waggons one a heavy true horse wagon and the other a light two horse wagon now if the Said Alcorn shall pay or cause to be paid to the Said pendleton the Said Sum of one hundred & fifty dollars according to the tenor and effect of a certain promissory note bearing even date herewith Executed by the Said Alcorn to the Said pendleton then the above property is to revert back to the Said Alcorn & if Said Sum of money is not paid according to the tenor of Said note then Said pendleton has the right to take Said property into his possession as his own property
