wing described premises situated in the County of Madison to wit
the North East quarter of the South West quarter Section no
Twenty five (25) in Township no Twenty Seven (27) north of Range
no Twenty Seven (27) west of the fifth 5th. P.M. Iowa contain-
ing forty (40) acres according to the original Survey and we
do hereby Covenant with the said Jacob Reigle that we are
lawfully seized of said premises that they are free from incum-
brance that we have good right and lawful authority to sell
the same and we do here Covenant to warrant and defend the said
premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever of
title and tax claims excepted in witness whereof we have here-
unto set our hands and seals this tenth day of July A.D. 1854
