Valentine Johnston & know all men by these
Bond, presents that I Valentine
Wheaty Harper & Johnston are held & firmly
Bound unto Whitty Harper in the sum of
thirteen hundred & four dollars this 11th day of June
A.D. 1833. the condition of the above bond is such
that whereas the said Johnston has this day sold
and agreed to convey to said Harper the following
Land for the sum of thirteen hundred & four
dollars to wit the North half of the N.W. 1/4 of sec (7)
seven and the N.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of sec seven (7) and the
North East 1/2 of the N.E. 1/4 of sec No twelve (12)
all in Township No seventy four and Range
twenty seven (27) except the 40. in sec twelve
which in Twp 4. and Range 28. the said Harper has
paid in hand seven hundred dollars and given

his Note of even date heretofore for the balance
six hundred and four dollars payable to the order of said
Johnston on or before the first day of Sept 1833
Now if on the payment of said note
promptly when and the said Johnston shall
make to said Harper a good and sufficient
deed for said Land then the above Bond shall
be null and void otherwise in force witness
