 Article of Agreement entered between David Harrison
 & James Harris of the first part and James Harris
 of second part with witness that

Said James Harris is to take care of said Mare
 eight years old about fifteen hands by to have
 to sell for said David Harrison for not less than eighty
 dollars and as much more as said Harris can get for
 her and if said Harris cant sell said Mare by
 the first of October next she is to be put up and
 sold at public sale to the highest bidder also then
 a sum of Brick out of the Mill at or near said
 David Harrison that was made and burnt by him
 for to bring one hundred dollars to satisfy one
 promissory Note given by David Harrison with
 one James M. Jones dated June the first 1833
 due on or before the first of September provided
 that said David Harrison pays of said note on or
 before the first of October. Now then said James Harris
 is to give up said Mare given in good given
 under our hand this first day of September A.D.
 1833.
