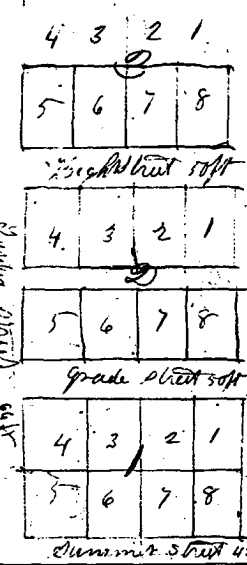

Bolsby Addition

April 18th 1856 Survey of an addition to the
town of Winfield (Madison Co Iowa) as
Bolsby addition for Mr. Bolsby. Bissiged division
of said lots No one, ten and nineteen of the south
addition to the town of Winfield (Madison
Co Iowa). Said lot is divided into three
blocks, which are numbered from south to north
each block is divided into eight lots, which are
numbered from corner west and east alternately
as shown on the plot here annexed. Block two has
an alley, sixteen and one half feet wide through
it east and west all the way sixteen feet wide



East and West the South line in Block one is one hundred and
twenty feet North and South the South line in Block two is one
hundred and one half feet North and South the South line is ninety
six feet and four inches North and South all the lots in Block three
is one hundred and fifteen feet and one half North and South all
the street one hundred and one half feet wide correctly marked
on each in the plot here annexed. I hereby certify that the above
named addition was surveyed and plotted as herein described.
