 consideration of the sum of twelve hundred dollars  
 in hand paid to us by said John Wilcox  
 of Madison County and State of Iowa the following  
 described premises to wit the South West quarter of the North  
 West quarter of section No. Eighteen (18) in Township No.  
 Seventy five (75) North of Range No. twenty seven (27)  
 & the North West quarter of South West quarter of section  
 No. eighteen (18) and the South East quarter of the North  
 East quarter of section No. Thirteen (13) in Township No.  
 Seventy five (75) & Range No. twenty eight (28) in Madison  
 County and State of Iowa And we do hereby covenant  
 with the said John Wilcox that we are lawfully king  
 of said premises that they are free from encumbrances that  
 we have got right and lawful authority to sell the  
 same And we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend  
 the said premises against the lawful claims of all  
 persons whatsoever And the said Unica Banks hereby  
 relinquishes all her right of common in and to the above
