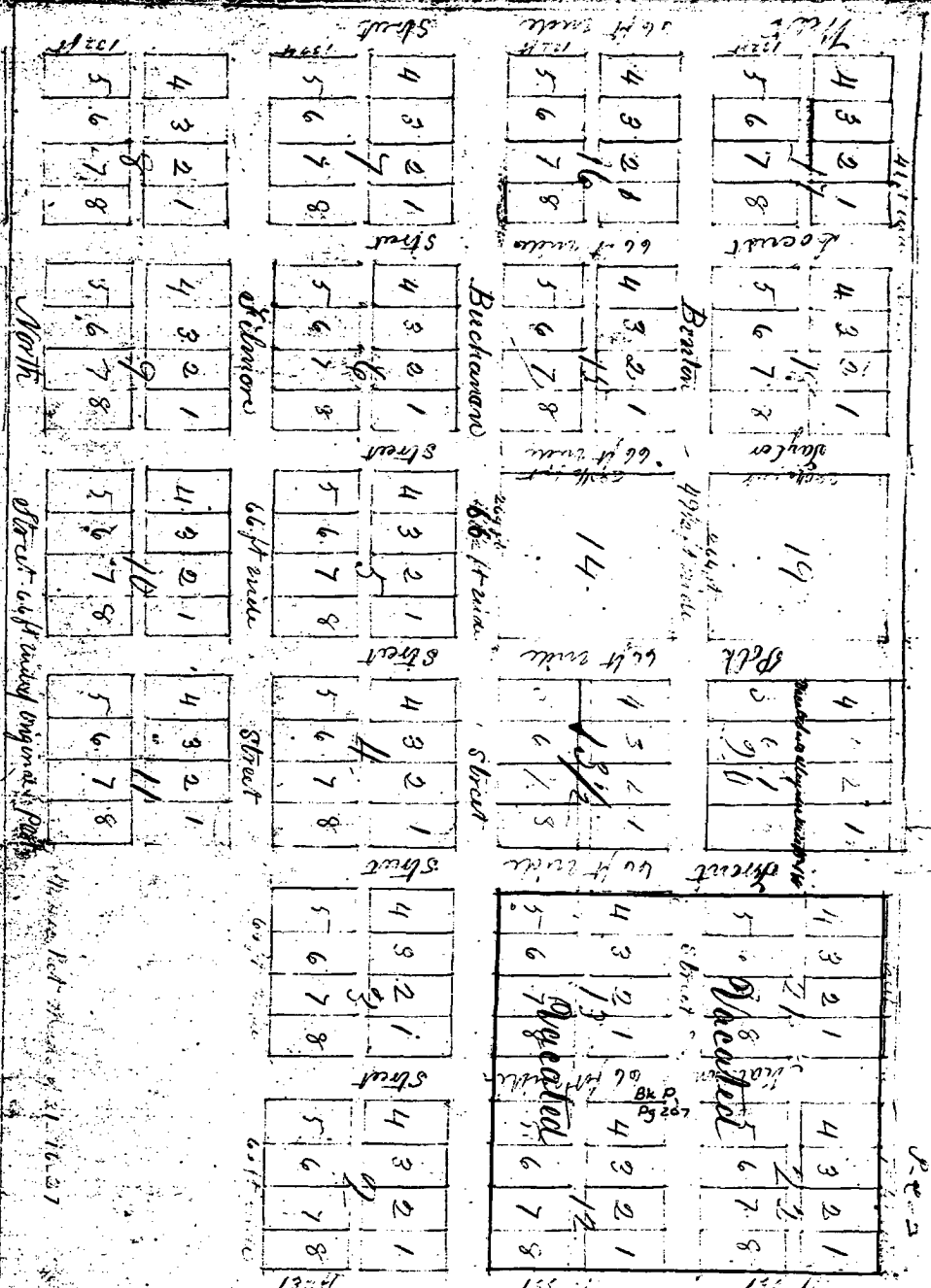

Survey of St. Louis and Knight addition to the town of St. Louis & Madison County Iowa. made by request of John & Peter St. Louis addition is bounded as follows: beginning at the N. E. corner of the 3rd Block of the 7th Range of the 1st Township West 20th Range North 20th Range East 30th Range North 14th Range West 10th Range North 20th Range East in place of beginning the above plot is divided into Block 4 streets the streets all with six foot wide except Benton and Buckman. Benton is 49 1/2 feet wide and Buckman is 15 feet wide at the East end and 41 feet at the West the names of streets is Benton and the street is shown on the plot here annexed and Block is divided into 14 lots which are numbered from the North West corner of the plot and are numbered 1 through 14. Each lot is sixty six feet east and west and one hundred and thirty two feet North and South. I hereby certify that the above plot was surveyed and plotted as herein described.

Pitzer to me personally known to be the identical persons whose names they represent themselves to be and acknowledged the disposition of the said lands as shown in and by said map and field notes subdivided said lot and thorough into streets and alleys, Blocks and Lots etc. This was done and Voluntary consent was in accordance with the laws and the said Elizabeth J. Pitzer acknowledged that she freely and voluntarily relinquished all her right of dower in and to so much of said lands as is in and by the said map and field notes appropriated to streets and alleys.
