 section ten and North West quarter of the North West quarter
 of section ten and the South West quarter of the North
 West quarter of section ten and the North East quarter
 of the South West quarter of section ten and North East
 quarter of the North East quarter of section nine (S) and
 the South half of the North West quarter of the North West
 quarter of section nine and the North half of the South
 East quarter of the North East quarter of section nine
 containing thirty acres more or less and the North West
 quarter of the North West quarter of section fifteen all in
 Township twenty six North of Range twenty six West
 of 5th M in the State of Ohio and containing in all three
 hundred and twenty acres. And we do hereby covenant
 with the said George M. Gray that we are lawfully signing
 said premises that they are free from incumbrance that
 we have good right and lawful authority to sell the
 same and we do hereby covenant to warrant and
 defend the said premises against the lawful claims
 of all persons whomsoever and the said James
 Finan hereby releasing us his right of recover
 y and to the above premises signed this first day
 of September A.D. 1836
