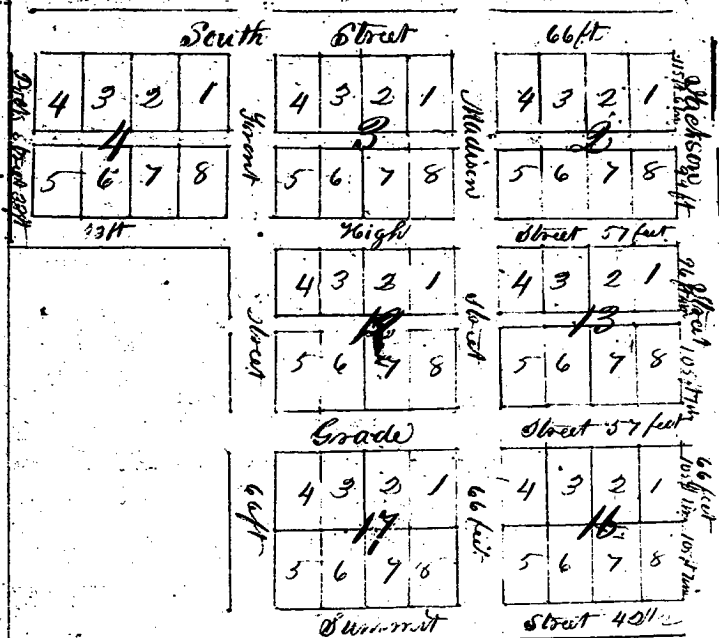


J. D. Jones Addition

April 16th 1856.
Survey of J. D. Jones addition to the town of this last Madison County town. Said addition being a division of out lots, to wit, those purchased from William Adams and a portion of the south addition to the town of Westport. Said addition is divided into seven blocks which are numbered as the original out lots as shown on the plat each block is divided into eight

lots which are numbered from the N.E. corner west and east alternately as shown on the plat hereto annexed. Blocks two three four twelve and thirteen each have an alley between and one half lot wide through them East and West. The lots are all forty feet East and West. The North East of lots in Blocks two three four and five are one hundred and fifteen feet North and South, and the South East of them are nine feet North and South. The North East of lots in Blocks twelve and thirteen are twenty six feet and four inches North and South. The North East of lots in Blocks sixteen and seventeen are one hundred and five feet and seven inches North and South. All the lots in Blocks sixteen and seventeen are one hundred and five feet and seven inches North and South. The streets are all marked and the width of each marked on the plat hereto annexed.

I hereby certify that the above named addition was by me surveyed and plotted as herein described.
