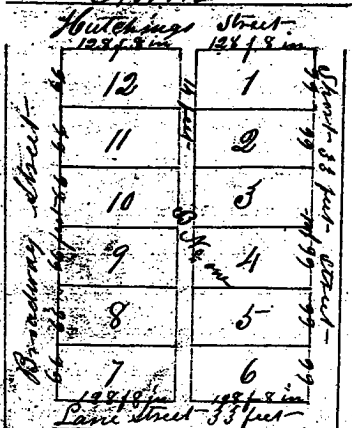


Shaw's addition to the Town of Winterset

Shaw's addition

Oct-30th A.D. 1856. Survey of the above named addition was made by request of Martin Shaw as herein described being a division of lots five six and seven of Hutchings addition to the town of Winterset Madison Co Iowa.

Said lots is divided into twelve lots which are numbered from North East corner south an North alternately as shown on the plat hereto annexed.

The lots are all one hundred and twenty eight feet and eight inches East and West and sixty six feet North and South. There is an alley fourteen feet wide through the block North and South. Short Street is thirty three feet wide and is on the East side of Plot. Lane Street is on south end is thirty three feet wide as shown on the Plot hereto annexed.
