eight hundred and fifty five John A. Pelt of the County
of Madison and State of Iowa filed certain petition in
the District Court within and in said County against Samuel
Beedle a Non resident of said State claiming of the said
Samuel Beedle the sum of twenty two dollars as Money just
due him from the said Samuel Beedle in books account
and asking that a writ of attachment may be issued
for goods and chattels and lands and tenements of the said

County - And whereas the said John A. Pelt then and there filed
with the Clerk of said Court his bond with sureties approved
by the said Clerk for the use of the said Samuel Beedle
conditional according to law and whereas the said

issued a writ of attachment under his hand and
the Seal of said Court directed to the Sheriff

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of said County Commanding him of good and
 Charles and land and tenements of the said Edmund
 Buel in said County not exempt from execution
