Deed F  
This Deed, made and entered into  
the <sup>1<sup>st</sup> day of October, in the year of  
1813, by and between Thomas G. Morrison  
our Lord & John Andrew (Husband and  
wife) by and between Castor B.  
(Boyle) of the County of Andover and State of Missouri, of the  
first part and Thomas G. Morrison and John Andrew of the  
County of Madison and State of Iowa of the second part,  
Witnesseth that the said parts of the first part for ever in consideration  
of the sum of eight hundred dollars, during to have in hand paid  
the said parts of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby Confirmed  
and acknowledged, have given granted, Bargained, Sold, Conveyed and Confirmed  
unto the said parts of the second part and to his heirs and  
assigns forever, two certain tracts of land, lying and being in the  
County of Madison and State of Iowa as follows:</sup>

The West half of the North East quarter of Section 10, nearly  
(2d) and the other half of the South west quarter of Section 10  
Leavenworth (7), both in Township No. Sixty Six (66) of Range 6  
Trenton Town (27) containing two hundred and sixty acres  
agreable to Government Survey.

It is known and to all the said tracts given as per above  
of lands with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging  
or in any way appertaining unto him the said party of  
the second part and to his heirs and assigns hereinafter  
the said party of the first part for himself his heirs and assigns  
successors or administrators to convey and agree that he will  
warrant and forever defend the title to the said tracts, pieces or  
parcels of lands and every part thereof unto them the said parties  
of the second part that he has no assign against the said tract or  
any claim of any persons whatsoever claiming unto them the  
same or any part thereof.
