 years old and one year old calf and I warrant them free from encumbrance
 and against any adverse claim upon condition that if I pay to said
 Beckwith & Cooper one hundred & sixty dollars which they ^{Beckwith & Cooper} hold against
 me in three several promissory notes the first calling for the sum
 of twenty dollars payable eight months after date the second for the sum
 one hundred & five dollars payable one year after date the third for the
 sum of thirty five dollars payable sixteen months after date all of said
 notes draw interest from the date of this deed this deed shall be void
 otherwise in full force & effect Witness my hand this Dec 29/
