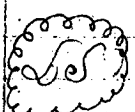

This Indenture made this 21st day of August 4th 1856 between Edward Shower of the first part and Richard H. Leggett of Jefferson Co, Iowa (204th dale) of the second part Witnesseth that the said party of the first for the consideration of two hundred & four dollars & 00/100 Dollars the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents Grant Bargain Sell and Convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the following described tract of Real Estate lying and being situated in the county of Madison and State of Iowa to-wit: South fractional 1/2 of the South West 1/4 of Sec. No twenty (20) in Township No twenty Seven (27) N of Range No twenty Seven (27) West of 5th P. M. Iowa containing 121 3/4 Acres more or less. to have and to hold said premises above described unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edward Shower will forever warrant and defend the title against all persons whomsoever and the said - hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the foregoing described premises in testimony whereof the said party of the first part has hereunto set his hand and Seal the date first above written
