 Presents shall come greeting. Whereas in Pursuance of the
 act of Congress, Approved September 28th 1850 Entitled
 an act granting Bounty Lands to Certain Officers and Soldiers
 who have been Engaged in the Military Service of the United
 States. Warrant No 143 for 160 acres issued in favor of
 Frederick Harbaugh, Sergeant in Captain Leekins Com-
 any Thirty Eighth Regiment United States Infantry War of
 1812 has been returned to the General Land Office with
 evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North
 West quarter of Section Thirty Three in Township Seventy
 Six North, of Range Twenty Eight West in the district of
 lands subject to sale, at Fort Des Moines Iowa containing
 One hundred and Sixty acres. According to the Official
 plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the
 General Land Office by the Surveyor General.
 Now Know ye that there is therefore granted by the United
 States unto the said Frederick Harbaugh - laugh and
 to his heirs and assigns forever

 caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of General
 Land Office to be hereunto affixed
