Field notes of the Town plot of Grandview Surveyed by order of John Bullock, and Maxwell McCauley Aug 10th 1855 beginning at the North West corner of the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section twenty two in Township twenty four north Range twenty eight west Thence West 2 1/2 miles South 11.50 East 16.75 North 11.50 West 2 1/2 miles to the place of beginning the above described plot is laid out as follows Each Block is Seventeen Rods Square with two alleys Sixteen and a half feet wide crossing at right angles in the centre of the Blocks number from North East corner West to three then East to six South of one as shown on the plat; the lots are all sixty six feet East and West and one hundred and thirty two North and South and are numbered from north east corner of Block West to four then East eight South of one as shown on plat. The streets are all sixty six feet wide and cross each other at right angles running parallel with the section. The streets are named as shown on the plat first on the West Franklin St. Second (South) Main St. South Side of the plat South St. Beginning at East side of plat East St. Second Monroe Street Third Washington St. Fourth West St. There is a stone at the North West corner of Block No 2 and South West of Block No 4 and North East of Block five and six as shown on the plat.
