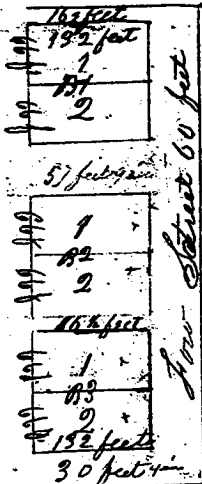

May 5th A.D. 1837 Survey



of an addition to the town of
Winterset Madison County
Iowa by request of Samuel Weeks
to his known as Weeks addition
to Winterset said addition is bounded
as follows beginning twenty seven rods
West of a point of road south of the
North East corner of the west half
of the North West quarter section
in township twenty five of Range
twenty seven W. thence North seven
chains eight three and one half links

Thence East two chains and sixty links thence South
Chains thence West two chains and sixty links
to place of beginning said addition is divided into three
blocks by streets and each block is divided into lots
lots the lots and block is numbered from the North
South as shown on the plat thence north then west
of the streets one block is marked thence on in feet
and inches each lot is one hundred and thirty two
feet east and West and sixty six feet North and South
as shown by the survey on the plat thence north
hereby certify that the above named addition was
surveyed and plotted as hereby represented

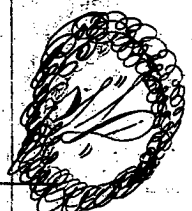
