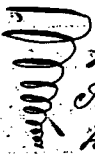

 unto Daniel Mulvale, James Hamish & John Hamish
 of Clark County and State of Iowa, the following described
 premises to wit: Thirty acres in the South West Quarter of
 Section One (1) in Township Seventy Six (76) North of
 Range 36 West of the 5th principal Meridian of Iowa
 Said thirty acres described as follows. It lies between
 5 acres taken off of the West side of the whole length of
 said forty acres North & South & five acres taken off the East
 side of said forty acres the whole length North & South of
 said quarter

And we do hereby covenant with the said Daniel Mulvale
 & James & John Hamish that we are lawfully seized
 of said premises; that they are free from incumbrance
 that we have good right and lawful authority to sell
 the same and we do hereby covenant to warrant and
 the said premises against the lawful claims of all
 persons whomsoever and the said Mary McLoughlin
 hereby relinquishes all her right & dower in and to
