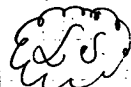

 Six (76) North of Range No Seventy Seven (27) Except four acres off the
 North east corner of the South West quarter of the South east quarter
 of Section nineteen and five (5) acres off the South West corner
 of the East half of the North West quarter of Sec Thirty and two
 acres of the South east corner of the West half of the West half

of the North East quarter of Section thirty (30) all in Township
 Seventy Six (76) Range One Twenty Seven (27) West containing one
 hundred and eighty nine (189) acres more or less
 and we do hereby Warrant and Defend the said premises
