State of Iowa Witness that the said Shaeffer
causes best known to himself does hereby agree to
and with said Hillman to place with and

On this 3rd day of Sept. 1854
 David Shaeffer and James J. Hillman hereby
 agree to and acknowledge the within Contract
 to be null and void David Shaeffer
 James J. Hillman

Under the Charge and Care of Sara Hillman his
 son John R Shaeffer aged Eleven years 14th Day of
 July last 1854 and the said Shaeffer does hereby
 agree to relinquish all care or Control over or to this said
 boy son other than the right to love and cherish his
 name as a good father ought and in Consideration for
 said relinquishment of said Control of said boy the
 said Hillman does hereby agree to receive said boy John
 R. and to take and adopt him as his own Child and fur-
 ther agrees to cloth. Educate and love and teach said

Every thing pertaining to the farming business and other-
 wise to take care of and to do and perform Every thing
 necessary for the well being and future prosperity of
 said boy as if he was my own Child in Testimony whe-
 reof we the said Shaeffer and Hillman have here-
 unto set our hands this 3rd Day of September 1854
