I now all men by these presents
that we John H. Gaff, James S. Gault
and John R. McCall the Trustees
of the first Presbyterian Church
in Winterset County of Madison
& State of Iowa, belonging
to the Synod of Iowa & West-
ern of Des Moines are held
and firmly Bound unto The

Trustees of the Church Erection fund of the General assembly of the
Presbyterian Church in the United States of America in
the sum of One Thousand Dollars, Lawful Money of the United
States of America, to be paid to the said Trustees of said
Church Erection Fund their Successors or assigns; for
which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves
our Successors and assigns, firmly by these presents, Sealed with
our Seal, Dated the fifteenth day of January One Thousand
Eight hundred and fifty seven.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that the above
bounden. The Trustees of the first Presbyterian Church in
Winterset their Successors or assigns shall well and truly pay
or cause to be paid unto the above named; the Trustees of
the Church Erection fund of the General assembly of the Presbyterian
Church in the United States of America, their Successors or assigns
the just and full sum of Three hundred forty seven Dollars
in four equal annual instalments of Eighty Six ^{75/100} Dollars
each. The first of said instalment on the first day of February
which will be in the Year One Thousand Eight hundred and
Sixty. and the like sum on the first day of February
in each Year thereafter, until the said four instalments are
fully paid then the above obligation to be void Else to
Remain in full force and virtue.

And it is hereby expressly agreed that should any
default be made in the Payment of the said instalment
or either of them or any part of either on any day
whereon the same is made payable as above expressed
and should the same remain unpaid and in arrear
for the space of thirty days then and from thenceforth
that is to say, after the lapse of ^{the} thirty days
the whole principal sum then remaining
unpaid shall be on interest from the

time of such default, until such installment with all the interest that may thus accrue thereon shall be fully paid; Any thing herein before contained, to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding,
