14 cups & saucers 2 window blinds 3 pictures also
certain other articles of house hold furniture
Enumerated in a Schedule of goods bought from
the said Wright marked A - and it is agreed
by the said parties that if the said Debush shall
pay three promissory notes executed by him to
the said Wright on the thirteenth day of November 1856
for the sum of Two hundred dollars according to
the time and tenor of said notes then this
obligation to be void otherwise to remain in
full force in Law & it is further agreed that the
said Debush shall retain possession of said
property herein Mortgages until default be made
without or hindrance.
