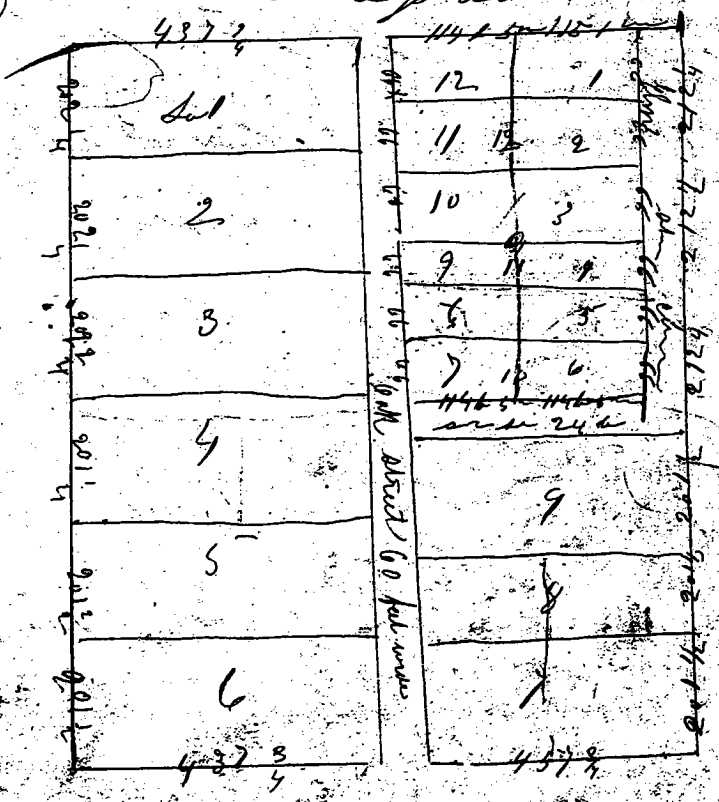

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Apr 15th 1856 Survey of Benjamin Linney addition
to the town of Westport. I made a survey of
Copper Canyon addition is bounded as
follows beginning at the South East corner
of the North West 1/4 of the North East 1/4 of section
one township seeing five N Range twenty eight
N thence West nine chains and sixty six one
one half links thence N twelve chains forty one
links East 9 1/2 chains South 124 1/4 chains said
addition is divided into nine lots and are
Block the lot number from NW corner South
and North to more as shown on plot Block
one is divided into twelve lots which
are numbered from North East corner
South and North as shown on plot all the
lots in Block one is one hundred and fourteen
feet and five inches east and west and six
feet both and South West street extends North and
South West street extends N and each is sixty feet
wide short street extends east and west and is
four feet wide the length of each line of the
Range lots is in links marked on the plot I
