To all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting,
 Know, Ye, That, Reposing Special Trust and confidence in the integrity and ability of Wm McCreary Esq. of St Charles Iowa, I James W. Grimes, Governor of the State of Iowa in the name and by the Authority of the People of Said State do Commission him Notary Public within and for the County of Madison in the State of Iowa, And do Authorize, Empower and require him to execute and fulfil the duties of that Office according to Law, and to have and to hold the Said Office with all the rights, Authorities, Privileges and Emoluments thereto Legally appertaining, for the term of three years; unless sooner removed by the Governor.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto Set my hand and caused to be Affixed the Great Seal of the State of Iowa. Done at Iowa City this, Twenty fifth day of April in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and fifty Six, of the Independence of the United States The Eightieth and of this State, the Tenth.
