 in consideration of the sum of two thousand
 Dollars in hand paid by Joseph Slater hath
 bargained and sold and doth hereby grant bargain
 sell and convey unto the said Joseph Slater and
 unto his heirs and assigns forever the following
 premises situate in the County of Boone in the
 state of Iowa and bounded and described as
 follows to wit Being The following tracts of land

First the North half of the south west quarter and south east quarter of the south west quarter of section No thirty three (33) in Township No eighty four (84) North of range No twenty eight (28) west of 5th P.M. Iowa containing 120 acres more or less. Second the South 1/2 of South East 1/4 & the South East 1/4 of the South West 1/4 of section No thirty four (34) & the South 1/2 of the North East 1/4 & the North West 1/4 of the North East 1/4 of section No seven (7) in Township No eighty four (84) North of range No twenty eight (28) West of 5th P.M. Iowa containing 240 acres more or less. Third the North half of the North East 1/4 & South East 1/4 of the North East 1/4 of section No Eighteen (18) in township No eighty four and the North West 1/4 of section No one (1) in Township No twenty seven (27) North of range No twenty eight (28) (both pieces) west of 5th P.M. Iowa containing

173 4/5 acres more or less. The first of the above described tracts of land was conveyed to said Blewing by Thomas Craighead & wife by deed August 16th 1856 the last two by Edward Shovers by Deed dated December 16th 1856 and also the North East quarter of the North East quarter of section No 7 in township No 84 North of range 28 west of the 5th P.M. Iowa containing 40 acres more or less to have and to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Joseph Slater & unto his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Isaac Blewing for himself and heirs doth hereby covenant with the said Joseph Slater & his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid and that the premises are free and clear from all encumbrances whatever and that he will forever Warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the said Joseph Slater and unto his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
