Townsend and all other the boots shoes & leather or other the goods chattles or merchandise by them the said George A Smith and Josiah Arnold as partner purchased under whatever name of whosoever or at whatever time or place the same may have been purchased and for and in consideration thereof the said Josiah Arnold agrees and promises to the said George A Smith to pay all the debts now or hereafter contracted by the said George A Smith and Josiah Arnold as partners under whatever name with whosoever or at whatever time or place the same may have been contracted in their said business of buying leather boots and shoes and of manufacturing and selling the same and to pay to the said George A Smith the sum of one hundred Dollars on or before the 9th day of July A.D. 1857 according to the tenor and effect of a certain promissory note of even date herewith executed by the said Josiah Arnold to the said George A Smith calling for the said sum of ~~any~~ one hundred dollars and payable on or before the 9th day of July A.D. 1857 aforesaid and by mutual consent of the said George A Smith and Josiah Arnold the partnership heretofore existing between them in the aforesaid business is hereby dissolved.
