for the absolute conveyance of the following describe
tract or tracts of land situate lying and being in said
Madison County to wit "the east half of the south
east quarter and the south west quarter of the North
east quarter of section thirty three (33) in

Township Seventy six 76 North of Range twenty seven west of the fifth principal meridian containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less or any part thereof with such clauses covenants and agreements to be therein contained as my said attorney shall think fit and expedient. Hereby ratifying and confirming all past bargains sales contracts deeds covenants and conveyances which shall at any time hereafter be sealed executed and delivered by my said attorney touching or concerning the premises.

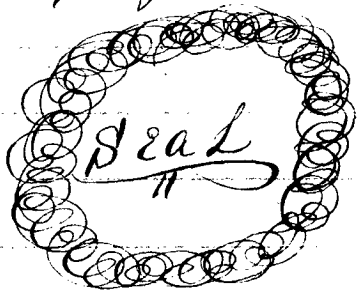
