Christopher Thompson presents that we Isaac Bell and John Heam of Madison County Iowa do hereby sell & convey unto Christopher Thompson the following described personal property lying in said County for the consideration of one hundred dollars in hand paid to wit the two thirds of six acres of wheat and the two thirds of thirty acres of corn being in Walnut Township being on the farm of Benjamin Brown in said township and County and warrant and defend the right of ownership to same now the condition of the above mortgage is such that if the said shall well & truly pay a certain promissory note of even date herewith calling for one hundred dollars on or before the 1st day of November A.D. 1857 said note

bearing ten percent interest from date then this bond or Mortgage to be null & void otherwise to be in full force & effect in law
