Holwell of Madison County and State of Iowa the following described premises to wit the south east quarter of the North east fourth of section twenty-four (24) of Township No. twenty six (26) North of Range No. twenty and (27) West and the North east fourth of the North West fourth of section No. twenty nine (29) and four acres off of the South East end of the South East fourth of the South West fourth of section No. Twenty (20) in Township twenty six (26) North of Range No. (26) W. Containing in all eighty four acres And we do hereby warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
