Thomas Hodgson presents that I Thomas Hodgson of the County
of Madison State of Iowa do this day sell to David
Cracraft of Madison County State of Iowa the following described
property to wit One large ox Wagon and One yoke of Oxen being
property that the said Hodgson bought of Marshal One yoke of Mule
Oxen known as the Brapfeld oxen One yoke of red and white oxen
brought to the County by him the above obligation are
such that if the said Hodgson shall pay a certain note given by
himself and W. S. Torrence and signed by the said Cracraft as security
for One hundred and seventy Dollars due June first 1858 to one mar-
shal of Adams County State of Iowa the above to be void otherwise to be
in full force
