confidence in, the integrity and ability of Albert
West of Winterset I James W. Grimes
Governor of the State of Iowa in the name
and by the authority of the people of said
State do commission him Notary Public within
and for said county of Madison in the State
of Iowa And do authorize empower and require
him to execute and fulfil the duties of that
office according to law and to have and to
hold the said office with all the rights author-
ities privileges and emoluments thereunto legally
appertaining for the term of three years unless
sooner removed by the Governor.
