face one New Cow line back four years old last Spring with the buck
ing calf belonging to the said several cows also one other black cow two
years old and one redish brindle Steer also one two horse Wagon supposed to be
\$40.00 for the sum of three hundred dollars in hand paid and I warrant the title
to the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever the above sale to be void
upon the following condition to wit whereas the said John Harinton is indebted
to the said John Cunningham in the sum of three hundred dollars evidenced by a
note of even date herewith calling for the payment of three hundred dollars one year
from date Now if said John Harinton shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid the
said sum of three hundred dollars as aforesaid then this sale to be void Otherwise to
be in full force at Law Witness my hand this 16th day of June 1858
